Many of our teas are seasonal, meaning we may not always have the same teas in stock. We'll keep you updated as teas come and go, but our rare and special teas may only be available in limited quantities.

Tea by the Pot

- **Scented Teas** Our House Scented Teas add a single aromatic flavor note to our premium tea leaves. The original character of the tea is preserved, but given new depth with these unique ingredients.
- Ruby Slippers There's no place like home, and this transportive tea will carry you to your comfort zone.

 Roses add a flowery cushion to our robust Kilimanjaro Black tea, and extend its inherent sweetness to a long, lingering finish.
- Yellow Brick Road These 'yellow bricks' are osmanthus flowers, scattered throughout our Climber's Brew
 Darjeeling Black Tea. The unmistakable osmanthus fragrance hovers over the brew, and its flavor is not like anything else: sweet flowers blooming, coating every corner of your mouth with honey.
- First Snow Jasmine An enduring classic, high-grade green tea scented with Jasmine flowers, for a honey-sweet and floral experience. 7.5
- Sundrops Yuja is a citrus fruit, similar in character to a grapefruit with a bit of orange. Scenting our Woodland Spring Korean green tea with yuja rounds out the grassy and nutty feel of the original with fragrant and tart citrus notes. Bright like a sunrise, this blend offers calming energy, a focused alertness, and a zesty sharpness.
- **Single Origin Teas -** Our Single-Origin Teas are pure tea experiences that highlight their source. Discover how *di wei* 'earth flavor' affects the resulting tea.
- The Red Queen "All the ways about here belong to me." Indulge in this resplendent Black Tea from Sichuan. 7
- Woodland Spring This green tea from Hadong, South Korea combines the savory richness of Japanese sencha with the light nuttiness of a Chinese dragon well. The tea offers a clean mineral finish, with a hint of honey; a contemplative tea that makes a wonderful accompaniment to meditation.
- Silver Spring Surround yourself with flowers, and clear spring water. The subtle flavor of this contemplative 7 tea highlights its other qualities the floral aroma, the silky texture soothing the throat. This tea carries the promise of renewal, of Spring.
- Guan Yin's Mercy Awake to a feeling of serenity and purpose with this tea, which soothes even as it energizes. 7 Luxurious caramel and hazelnut notes surround the sparkly, magical essence of Taiwan oolong teas.
- **Dark Moon** Ripe (shu) Pu-erh is a fermented tea, perfect after a heavy meal, soothing on the throat and the stomach. The ancient forests of Yunnan, China are the origin of all camellia-leaf tea.

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- **Herbals** Our caffeine-free herbals are driven by specific flavor notes, and have long associations with a variety of health benefits.
- Yuja Yuja is a citrus fruit, similar in character to a grapefruit with a bit of orange. Known as "yuzu" in Japan, 7 the same fruit is grown in Korea and used to make a subtle yet sharp herbal tea. This caffeine-free brew is sure to bring a smile to your face.
- **Hibiscus Rose** Tart and bright, this Herbal is an instant mood booster. Hibiscus flowers are blended with citrus, and tempered with rose hips for a floral aroma and mouthwatering finish.
- Turmeric Ginger The potent spices of turmeric and ginger are mellowed with lemon myrtle to produce 6.5 this zesty and fragrant Herbal.
- Peach Elixir Bursting with fruit flavor and a lingering vibrant energy. Peaches are vitamin-rich, high in antioxidants, and anti-inflammatory. Honeybush and Green Rooibos, African herbs traditionally taken as tea, may help relieve diabetes, increase metabolism, and lower blood pressure.
- **Gong Fu Service** Our Gong-Fu style service is based on traditional Chinese tea preparation methods. Small clay pots offer a higher ratio of leaf to water, with shorter brewing times maximizing aroma and flavor. This also allows for repeated brews, so you can experience all aspects of the tea as it changes moment to moment. Don't miss this experience!
- Lightning Bug Like fireflies on a summer evening, this tea will entrance you. A portion of the farm is dedicated to an all natural growing method: no pesticides, no fertilizer, no weeding, and simply letting nature does its thing. The result is a beautifully rich and complex oolong.
- DHP One of the most famous of Chinese teas, Da Hong Pao was originally picked from 4 legendary tea 27.50 trees behind a monastery in Fujian, and the leaves, after carefully oxidizing and roasting, were reserved for the imperial family.
 - DHP offers a strong caramel in the early brews, watch as the smokey roast yields to more fruity notes in the later steeps.
- Dragonwell An ancient green tea, known for notes of toasted chestnuts balancing its savory richness.

 This particular Dragonwell is picked in early Spring 2025, during the 'pre-qingming' harvest period.

 In addition to the trademark nutty flavor, it offers a creamy sweetness that lingers long after tasting.
- Rivers & Lakes Be present and engage with this raw (sheng) pu-erh to discover elusive strawberry-cream 30 notes, the sting of iron, and a long lasting lingering sweetness (hui gan). This is a good tea for exploring cha qi, the energetic effects of tea on the body.
- Evening Songbird Ripe (shu) pu-erh is often shared after a heavy meal (fermented teas may aid digestion), 22 and its moderate caffeine content and grounding energy make it a comforting evening tea. This 2016 vintage pu-erh, or "dark tea", hails from Mengsong Mountain in Yunnan. In addition to the lush rain-forest notes, it offers an herbaceous cooling sensation.
- **Cold Brew Teas** Cold Brewing tea allows the full flavor of the tea to open up without being diluted.

 A delicious and refreshing way to experience tea on a hot day with or without sweetener.

 Cold Brews are prepared a day in advance, and available while supplies last. Ask about today's flavors!
